## Wage Subsidies for Employers

- Student Eligibility
- Registered as a domestic student in a recognized post-secondary institution.
- Canadian citizens, permanent residents, or persons to whom refugee protection has been conferred under the Immigration and Refugee Protection Act.
- Legally entitled to work in Canada in accordance with relevant provincial or territorial legislation and regulations.
- Must have a work-integrated learning component (co-op or internship)
  within their study plan.
- Can be from any program of study (business, science, tech, engineering, arts).





Eligible employers may receive up to 75% coverage of student wages (to a maximum of \$7,500) for each work term placement.

## Wage Subsidies for Employers

- Registered Canadian businesses, not-for-profits, hospitals, long-term care facilities and post-secondary institutions (universities, colleges, and polytechnics).
- Federal, Provincial, Territorial and Municipal Government does not qualify.
- · Are committed to paying the student for the role.
